Memorandum of Understanding

The Supply Register and the NASUWT are pleased to announce a new Memorandum of Understanding to promote an ethical alternative for the employment of supply teachers.

The pay and conditions of teachers are inextricably linked to the provision of high-quality education. Supply teachers play a vital role in ensuring the highest standards of education for all children and young people. However, the way in which the supply agency market has operated has often been to the detriment of supply teachers and schools. Our new partnership aims to deliver a positive change for the benefit of supply teachers and schools.

The Supply Register and the NASUWT are committed to ending the cycle where supply teachers get less, schools pay more and supply agencies make excessive profits. The Memorandum of Understanding between the Supply Register and the NASUWT represents a better deal for supply teachers, including:

- ◆ all agencies operating for the Supply Register adopt an ethical code of conduct, underpinned by the principle that supply teachers make a vital contribution to the education of children and young people;
- ◆ all policies and procedures applicable to supply teachers are developed and agreed with the NASUWT;
- ◆ supply teachers using the Supply Register are paid in accordance with agreed, guaranteed national daily rates;
- ◆ all supply teacher assignments fully comply with the Agency Workers' Regulations (AWR);
- ◆ main pay range pay progression up to UPS1 within six years;
- ◆ a commitment to campaign to secure access to the Teachers' Pension Scheme (TPS); and
- ◆ guaranteed CPD opportunities.
