### Ten top tips for a healthy classroom

- There are no trip hazards, such as loose carpets or trailing leads
- Furniture, fixtures, fittings (including electrical sockets) are safe
- There is a thermometer to check that the temperature is reasonable
- The windows open easily, or there is some other form of ventilation
- The exit/evacuation routes are clearly signposted
- There are no strange/unpleasant smells
- There are no signs of mould growth, damp or leaks
- There is a comfortable workstation
- The room is clean without any accumulation of rubbish
- The lighting is appropriate to the work undertaken
