## **NASUWT Notice Board Pack**

Please find enclosed your copy of the latest Notice Board Pack – a resource to support you in ensuring that the NASUWT notice board in your workplace is attractive, informative and regularly updated with relevant content.

A well-maintained and up-to-date NASUWT notice board is vital in helping to:

- recruit and organise members effectively in the workplace by showing the Union is actively supporting its members; and
- keep our members up to date and informed of the work of the Union in their workplace, locally, regionally and nationally.

The Union produces a range of materials throughout the year that can be used to refresh your notice board and keep members engaged. This pack contains some longer-term materials that you can localise and update as needed.

While there is no statutory right for facilities for union representatives, except for representatives engaged in duties related to collective redundancies and the transfer of undertakings, the NASUWT has negotiated agreements with most employers.

Employers should, where practical, make available to union representatives the facilities necessary for them to perform their duties efficiently and to communicate effectively with their members, other representatives and full-time officers, including access to notice boards. (ACAS)
